Epsom Salts for plants is a source of magnesium sulfate that is essential for healthy growth and development. It is required to produce chlorophyll which helps plant life obtain energy from light. It also gives plants their healthy green color. Leaf yellowing is often a symptom of deficiency.

Epsom Salts as a soil amendment helps create an ideal organic growing environment for healthy, productive plants. Healthy soil requires the correct balance of magnesium, sulfur, potassium, and nitrogen.

Epsom Salts is an inexpensive, organic, easy-to-use, natural plant growth stimulant that perks up tired plants and promotes new growth.

Before applying **Epsom Salts**, however, it's a good idea to have your soil tested to determine whether it's deficient in magnesium.

You should also be aware that many plants, like beans and leafy vegetables, will happily grow and produce in soils with low levels of magnesium.

Plants like rose, tomatoes and peppers, on the other hand, require lots of magnesium, and therefore, are more commonly watered with **Epsom Salts**.

When diluted with water, **Epsom Salts** is easily taken up by plants, especially when applied as a foliar spray.
